# 1 Overview

---

NFuse pages generated by the wizard have an input box for the domain part of the user's credentials. If the user is part of multiple domains, the input box can be replaced with a combo box listing all available domains.



## 2 Details

---

If applications are published within a domain scope, then logging in under a different domain can result in a different application set. If applications are published in a farm scope, then servers from different domains with published applications can exist in the same farm. Thus logging in under different domains can give you a different application set as well as different permissions within any given app that the user launches. If this type of multiple domain environment exists, a combo box can be used to replace the input box for domain entry in the login page. This will facilitate user logons as well as restrict them from attempting to logon to a restricted domain.

To implement this a modification needs to be made to the login.htm file. The login.htm file generated by the wizard contains an input tag for the domain field:

```
<input type="text" name="domain">
```

This can be replaced with:

```
<select name="domain">  
  <option name="domain1" value="domain1's name">domain1's name</option>  
  <option name="domain2" value="domain2's name">domain2's name</option>  
  // continue will all the domains you want to make available  
</select>
```
