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1 Overview

This document demonstrates a step-by-step process to publish print manager on a Windows 2000 TSE running MetaFrame 1.8.



2 Instructions

1. Login into the MetaFrame server where you want to publish Print Manager
2. Open Explorer
3. Create the following folders:
 - C:\Printers.{2227A280-3AEA-1069-A2DE-08002B30309D}
 - C:\Apps\Explorer
5. These folders MUST be created in the root of one of your Metaframe server drives.
When you press <enter> after creating this folder, you will notice that the folder icon changes to a printer icon.
6. Make a copy of C:\WINNT\Explorer.exe
7. Place this file in C:\Apps\Explorer and rename it Explorer2.exe
8. Open Published Application Manager
9. Click Application | New
10. Enter an Application Name and Detailed Description
11. Click Next
12. Select Explicit
13. Click Next
14. Type the following in the Command Line box:
C:\Apps\Explorer\Explorer2.exe /n,/root,C:\Printers.{2227A280-3AEA-1069-A2DE-08002B30309D}
15. Type C:\Apps\Explorer in the Working Directory box.
16. Click Next
17. Click Next
18. Select your desired Sound, Video, Encryption, Window Size and Window Colors Settings
19. Click Next
20. Enter a Neighborhood Folder name if desired
21. Click Next
22. Select the Users/Groups that you want to have access to this application
23. Click Next
24. Click Next
25. Click Finish
26. Now open Program Neighborhood and refresh the Application Set.
27. Use the credentials of a user who has access to the newly published Print Manager.
28. You should now see the Print Manager published application.
29. Double-click on the entry and login to test it.
